

**PROSPECTUS FOR THREE YEAR UNITARY LL. B COURSE  
(ADDITIONAL BATCH-SELF-FINANCING)**

**ADMISSION FOR 2020-21**

**Introduction**

The Government of Kerala accorded sanction to re-introduce an additional batch for 3 year LL. B course at the Government Law College, Thiruvananthapuram in the self-financing stream. The course extends over a period of six semesters. Classes will be conducted regularly during working days from 7AM to 7PM (morning & evening). The course will be in accordance with the scheme and syllabi of the 3 year Unitary LL.B course of University of Kerala. As per U.O No. AC.B/01/21361/2014 dated 12/03/2015, affiliation was granted by the University as an academic course and the conversion of the course as professional will be subject to the approval of the Bar Council of India. Total number of intake will be sixty.

**Fee Structure**

Admission Fee	: Rs. 1000/- to be paid at the time of admission
Tuition fee	: Rs. 20000/- p.a to be paid in two instalments.
Library fee	: Rs. 1500/- to be paid in one instalment.
Caution deposit	: Rs. 2000/- to be paid at the time of admission.(Refundable)
University fee	: as prescribed by the University
Other fees (PTA, Moot court, ID card):	as decided by the college.

**Eligibility for Admission**

1. Candidates shall be Indian citizens employed in Thiruvananthapuram District and having not less than five years service on a regular basis.
2. Candidates seeking admission shall be graduates in any subject from Kerala University or of other Universities recognized by the said University with a minimum of 45% marks in the aggregate, (Part 1, 2 & 3) for general candidates, 42% for OBC and 40% for SC/ST.

**Reservation of Seats**

1. 30% of seats will be reserved for State Government Employees.

2. 5% of seats will be reserved for members of All India Service, who are in the service of Government of Kerala.
3. 5% of seats will be reserved for members of the Kerala Legislative Assembly and Parliament.
4. Principles of reservation as per relevant Government orders will be followed in the case of selection of candidates.
5. Vacant seats in any reservation quota will go to general merit.
6. Candidates seeking admission in reserved quota, except SC, ST, MLA, MP and all India Service Quota should attach non-creamy layer certificate from the village officer along with the application for getting benefit of reservation
7. Candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST quota should attach Caste/Community certificate from the officer concerned along with the application.

#### **Application forms**

The prospectus and application form for admission can be had from the college office on payment of Rs.1000/- (For SC/ST candidates the amount will be Rs. 500/-). The date of issue of application form and the last date for receipt of application will be notified in news papers and in the college notice board.

#### **Submission of Applications**

The filled up application together with the following documents should be submitted to the Principal, Government Law College, Barton Hill, Vanchiyoore P. O, Thiruvananthapuram -35, by post or hand delivery before the last date notified. The college authorities will not be responsible for postal delay.

1. Attested copies of the degree certificate and mark lists of all parts.(Part 1, 2 &3)
2. Employment certificate and no objection certificates from the employer.
3. Community/Caste certificate for SC/ST candidates.
4. Non-creamy layer certificate from the authority concerned.
5. Letter from Speaker concerned for candidates applying in the MLA and MP quota
6. Self-addressed, stamped post card.

#### **Selection Procedure**

1. Selection will be based on merit.
2. Separate quota will be fixed for Government and non-Government candidates.
3. Separate quota will be fixed for science and non-science streams in the proportion to the number of registered applicants in each category.
4. Weightage of 2% marks shall be given for Post-graduate Degree.
5. Admission of selected candidates will be made by the Principal after an interview.

**Liquidated Damages**

The candidates who obtain admission and discontinue studies after the closing of admission in the same year or in subsequent years are liable to pay Rs. 25000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) as liquidated damages.

**Admission**

1. Application defective in any respect or which do not contain the relevant documents or those received late will be summarily rejected. No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details after the submission of the application.
2. Interview cards will be sent to provisionally selected candidates and the candidate shall be present for interview at the hour and date noted in the interview card.
3. No candidate will be admitted unless he is present for an interview by the Principal.
4. The Principal may refuse admission to any candidate, whose character or previous conduct has not been satisfactory. If any candidate obtain admission by means of false certificates, documents or false representation he/she shall be guilty of misconduct and their admission will be summarily cancelled.
5. At the time of interview the original certificates should be submitted for verification. The following certificates shall be produced at the time of interview.
  - (a) Original degree certificate and mark lists of qualifying examination.
  - (b) Transfer Certificate in the prescribed form from the institution where the candidate last studied.
  - (c) Conduct certificate from the head of the office where he/she is working.
  - (d) Eligibility certificate from Kerala University, if the qualifying degree is from other Universities.
  - (e) Certificate from the Head of the Office to the effect that the candidate is a regular employee having not less than five years of service.
  - (f) Students qualified from Universities other than Kerala University shall produce Migration Certificate.
  - (g) Two recent passport size photographs.
