ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, No Objection Certificate was issued to Nehru College of Educational and Charitable Trust, Thrissur for conducting 3 year LL.B and 5 year Integrated BBA LL.B courses for the year 2015-16 under self financing stream at Nehru Academy of Law Lakkidi, Palakkad District. As per Government Order read as 2nd paper above, the NOC was renewed for the Academic year 2019-20.

2. The Registrar, University of Calicut as per the order read 3rd paper above has granted provisional affiliation to the above courses for the year 2020-21.

3. The Principal, Nehru Academy of Law, Lakkidi, Palakkad in the letter read as 4th paper above, requested to revalidate the NOC already issued to the educational agency for conducting 3 year LLB and 5 year BBA LL.B Courses for the year 2020-21 also. The Educational Agency, as per the reference 5th paper above, has executed an agreement with Government agreeing to abide by the terms & conditions prescribed in the original agreement and the rules and other issued by the Government from time to time.

4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to renew the No Objective Certificate for the academic year 2020-21 to Nehru Academy of Law,

Lakkidi, Palakkad for conducting 3 year LL.B course and 5 year Integrated BBALL.B course with an intake of 60 students each, subject to the following conditions.

i) the college shall seek NAAC accreditation by 2021.

ii) the college shall appoint faculty who are qualified as per rules including NET, as applicable.

5. The Management shall conduct only the course for which approval/affiliation has been received subject to the fulfillment of the conditions in the Agreement & Undertaking already executed by them with Government.

6. Government also order that the admission of students for the course and commencement of classes by the college shall be made only in accordance with the rules and regulations of the University concerned and Bar Council of India.
