### ORDER

As per the Government Order read above, NOC for conducting the self-financing / un-aided courses viz. (1)B.Com. Co-operation(40 seats), (2)BA English(30 seats), (3)B.Sc. Mathematics(25 seats) and (4)B.Com. Finance(40 seats) in St.Mary's Arts & Science College, Cherupanathady, Kasaragod was renewed for the academic year 2018-19. As per the application read as 2nd paper above, management of the educational institution has requested Government to renew the NOC, for the academic year 2019-20. The management has completed the formalities for the renewal of NOC in the revised pattern.

2. In the circumstances, Government are pleased to renew the NOC for conducting the self-financing / un-aided courses in St.Mary's Arts & Science College, Cherupanathady, Kasaragod, for the academic year 2019-20 as detailed below:

- (1)B.Com. Co-operation(40 seats),
- (2)BA English(30 seats),
- (3)B.Sc. Mathematics(25 seats) and
- (4)B.Com. Finance(40 seats)

### **The renewal sanction of NOC is subject to the following conditions:**

1. The Educational Agency shall give an Undertaking to the University about the presence of adequate infrastructure for conducting the course and the

presence of adequate NET qualified faculty.

2. The Educational Agency shall abide by the procedure of admission as decided by Government and set apart 50% of the seats of the course for being filled up by Government or such authority determined by Government on the basis of merit and reservation principles followed by Government and the remaining 50% to be filled up by the Educational Agency on the basis of merit.
3. The Educational Agency shall collect only such fees as determined by Government from time to time from the students admitted to the college for the courses and at any rate shall not enhance the fees in 2020-21 due to the downturn in economy following COVID-19.
4. The Educational Agency shall institute adequate number of scholarships on merit-cum-means basis as determined by Government from time to time to the students admitted to the courses.
5. The Educational Agency shall maintain a website and publish the details regarding the establishment and governance of the Educational Agency, admission, fees, courses, results, teaching and non-teaching staff, grievance redressal mechanism for students and any other information as required by Government.
6. The Educational Agency shall run only courses approved by Government and the University concerned.
7. The Educational Agency shall enable Government and its representatives to check, verify and monitor the compliance of the conditions mentioned above at any time Government so decides.
8. The No Objection Certificate / sanction granted shall be valid up to the end of the academic year 2019-20 and renewable on the request of the Educational Agency and subject to the satisfactory compliance of the conditions specified herein.
9. The service of the teaching and non-teaching staff of the aided stream shall not be utilized for the proposed unaided courses.
10. The College shall seek NAAC accreditation by the year 2021.
11. There shall be no financial commitment to Government for the proposed unaided course.
12. In the event of breach of any of the conditions mentioned above by the Educational Agency, Government is authorised to withdraw the sanction without notice to the educational agency, or adjudicate the quantum of compensation which the Educational Agency is liable to pay to Government, if any, and upon such adjudication, the Educational Agency should pay to Government the amount so fixed, failing which the amount of compensation adjudicated should be recoverable under the provision of Kerala Revenue Recovery Act, 1968, as if they were public revenue due on land.
13. The educational agency shall produce necessary documents for the continued affiliation from the University for the year 2019-20 before 31.08.2020

failing which the sanction issued will be treated as cancelled w.e.f. 01.09.2020 and Government will not be responsible for any loss incurred by the institution and the institution shall be solely responsible for the losses thereof.


14. The college shall apply for renewal of NOC by March every year.
