**ORDER**

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, No Objection Certificate was issued to MCT College of Legal Studies at Melmuri in Malappuram District for conducting 5 year BBA LL.B and 3 year LL.B Courses during the academic year 2015-16. 2. The Registrar, University of Calicut as per the order read as 4th paper above, has granted provisional affiliation to the above courses for the year 2019-20 .

The Secretary, MCT College of Legal Studies, Melmuri, Malappuram in the letter read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper above, has requested to revalidate the NOC already issued to the Educational Agency for the year 2019-20 for conducting above courses for the Academic year 2019-20 also. The Educational Agency, as per 6<sup>th</sup> paper above, has executed a fresh agreement with Government agreeing to abide by the terms & conditions prescribed in the original agreement and the rules and orders issued by Government from time to time.

4. In the above circumstances, Government are pleased to renew the No Objection Certificate issued to the Secretary, MCT College of Legal Studies, Melmuri, Malappuram, for conducting the following courses during the academic year 2020-21 also subject to the condition

- i) the college shall seek NAAC accreditation by 2021.  
ii) the college shall appoint faculty who are qualified as per rules including NET, as applicable
