ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st and 2nd papers above, No Objection Certificate was issued to CSI South Kerala Diocese, Thiruvananthapuram for starting a new Self Financing Law College by name CSI Institute of Legal Studies Cheruvarakonam in Thiruvananthapuram District under Self Financing Stream for conducting Integrated BALLB, BBA LLB, B.com LLB (5 year) and LLB (3 year) during the academic year 2012-13. As per the Government Order read in 3rd paper above, NOC for conducting the above courses were renewed for the academic year 2019-20 also.

2. The Registrar, University of Kerala as per the order read 4th paper above has granted provisional affiliation to the above courses for the year 2020-21.

3. The Bishop & Chairman, CSI South Kerala Diocese (SIUC) in his letter read as 5th paper above has requested to renew the NOC granted to the Educational Agency for the year 2020-21. The Educational Agency, as per the reference 6th paper above, has executed a fresh agreement with Government agreeing to abide by the terms & conditions prescribed in the original agreement and the rules and orders issued by Government from time to time.

4. In the above circumstances, Government are pleased to renew the No

Objection Certificate to CSI Institute of Legal Studies at Cheruvarakonam in Thiruvananthapuram District for conducting the following courses under Self Financing Stream during the academic year 2020-21, subject to the following conditions:

- i) the college shall seek NAAC accreditation by 2021.
- ii) the college shall appoint faculty who are qualified as per rules including NET, as applicable.

5. The Law College Management shall conduct only the course for which approval/affiliation has been received subject to the fulfillment of the conditions in the Agreement & Undertaking already executed by them with Government.

6. Government also order that the admission of students and commencement of classes by the college shall be made only in accordance with the rules and regulations of the University concerned and Bar Council of India.


