General Conditions for the works undertaken under AMF

- The amount sanctioned will be utilized only for renovation/maintenance of existing assets as stipulated in Kerala Asset Maintenance Fund Scheme 2009 and subsequent orders.
- The Director of Technical Education shall furnish a detailed estimate prepared by the approved Government Agency before executing the work . He shall also furnish action taken report in every three months to finance (Planning B) Department.
- All works are to be done in a transparent manner. Tender and other related formalities shall be followed wherever necessary with respect to civil works and purchase of equipments or articles.
- The utilization certificate duly countersigned by Head of Department concerned shall be submitted to Finance (Planning B) Department after completion of the project.
- Purchase of new assets/equipments of movable or immovable nature and construction of new buildings, compound walls extraneous to the maintenance of existing assets will not be eligible for assistance under AMF.
- The Director of Technical Education should ensure that, there would be no duplication of receiving funds for the same purposes.


